Outstanding housing projects that have made a huge impact on local communities are invited to enter the World Habitat Awards 2018.

The awards – which are now open for entry - are run in partnership with UN-Habitat, highlight the very best housing projects from across the world.

David Ireland, Director of World Habitat, the Awards' funders and co-ordinators said: "These awards are a great opportunity for you and your project to receive the recognition you deserve. We are not only looking for outstanding housing solutions but also where good housing is having a wider impact, on health on energy or improved community cohesion. Recent winners from the past few years have included projects which have had a significant impact on people's lives by tackling topics as wide-ranging as natural disasters and chronic homelessness."

David continues: "Being a finalist or winner will bring you international recognition for your innovative work, winning projects also receive a cash prize of £10,000, a trophy and have the opportunity to transfer their award-winning approach through peer-exchange activities sponsored by World Habitat."

All housing projects which demonstrate the best in practical, innovative and sustainable solutions to current housing needs are invited to submit their entries via the World Habitat Awards website www.worldhabitatawards.org. Entries must be received by **31 March 2018**.
